On the 2nd and 3rd of June 2019, the AEA and ECAT organised the AEA Mini Symposium and the AEA General Assembly in the Akademie für Hörakustik in Lübeck Germany.

At the AEA mini symposium the following topics were covered:

- The Medical Device Regulation and classification of Hearing Aids and Hearing Aid Fitting (Adaptation) – options and consequences. – Stephan Baschab
- The new French Reimbursement System – RAC 0 – details, first experiences and future – Hervé Picollet.
- How are hearing aids analysed and tested by the German Hearing Institute (DHI) – Dr. Hendrik Husstedt
- Regulations – Standards and Practices for Hearing Protection – Erik De Muyncck
- Instant, Disposable or Custom Hearing Protection. What should the Audiologist Advise? – Mark Laureyns board approved the “AEA European Hygiene Guidelines for Hearing Aid Professionals”
